Students represent approximately 70 nationalities and follow a British-based curriculum up to age 16, adapted to reflect our European context and international cohort providing (I)GCSE. Post-16 BSB is the only school offering three pre-university choices: GCE A Levels, the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma and BTEC vocational courses in Hospitality, Sport, Business and Applied Science. We also offer a bilingual French/ **English programme established for ages 4-14.**
